

Badger Box Frequently Asked Questions

1. Who is eligible for Badger Boxes?

Badger Box eligibility is based on income. If you make below the income requirements, you qualify. Please see our income eligibility sheet [here](#). If someone who is not eligible takes a box, they will have to **repay the value of the box** (\$80), and **may also be charged and prosecuted under state and federal laws**.

2. What do we need to bring to get a box?

You do not need to bring any materials to receive a Badger Box. You will sign up for a box at the distribution site. We take down your name, address, and number of people in your household.

3. Can we reserve a box?

No. Starting in 2023, Central Rivers Farmshed is no longer allowing participants to call ahead and reserve a box. This is in effort to keep the program as fair for all participants as possible.

4. Can we pick up a box for someone else?

Yes. You can pick up a box for someone else as long as they are income eligible, and you have their name, address, and number of people in your household. If they are not income eligible, they may face the same consequences listed above.

5. How often does Badger Box happen?

Badger Box distribution occurs once a month. Specific dates of distribution from Farmshed can be found on our home page of our [website](#). Typically distribution occurs the third Monday of each month.

6. How can we hear about Badger Box updates, such as when it is happening, if there are boxes left?
